## SERVICES FOR SURVIVORS

Children and adults can and DO recover from the trauma of sexual violence. PAAR offers comprehensive services to victims and their families.

- Free, confidential helpline available 24/7 to help those in crisis, or those requesting information.
- Emergency room support: An in-person advocate will accompany victims and their families in area emergency rooms to provide support and information through the medical exam.
- Legal advocacy and support through the legal process: An in-person advocate will accompany victims and their families to police and court proceedings.
- Adult Counseling: Individual and group counseling is provided to adult male and female victims of sexual violence.
- Child & Family Counseling: Individual traumafocused counseling is provided to children who have been sexually abused. PAAR also offers supportive counseling to family members.

## PREVENTION

PAAR partners with communities to create a coordinated sexual violence and abuse prevention plan. Together PAAR and communities can create safe and healthy relationships for everyone.

## **PROJECT TRAFFIC STOP**

For many, it may be surprising that **sex trafficking** exploitation of people for the purpose of commercial sex—happens in Allegheny County. Yet it does. The victims are as young as 13, all genders, some are immigrants, but most are domestic youth.

PAAR provides intensive case management, life skill classes, trauma and group therapy to address the comprehensive needs of trafficked individuals. The overall goal is to help the victim break free from their trafficker, heal from abuse, become self-sufficient, and build a strong support system.

### FACTS ON SEXUAL ABUSE

- Research indicates that as many as 1 out of 4 girls and 1 out of 6 boys will experience some form of sexual abuse before the age of 18.
- You are more likely to be assaulted by a friend, classmate, acquaintance, date, relative, neighbor or co-worker than by a stranger in a dark alley.
- A rape occurs every two minutes in America.
- Of the youth involved in sexual exploitation 70% to 90% have experienced past sexual abuse.
- While the majority of sex trafficking victims are female, men are also victims.
